

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Please submit your photos of Sanderstead to us by uploading to justiceandcare@sanderstead-parish.org.uk.
2. Images should be landscape digital pictures of high resolution in jpeg format .
3. Each photo must be taken in the Parish of Sanderstead.
4. Photographers should obtain permission from any identifiable people in their compositions prior to entering the picture into the competition.
5. Photos of children (under the age of 16) will only be accepted with explicit written consent from parents or guardians – it is the photographers responsibility to obtain this consent.
6. The competition is open to anyone, whether they are a resident of the parish or not.
7. Photographs with text added to the image will not be accepted (date stamps automatically added by the camera will not be accepted).
8. Entry to the competition assumes permission to include the photos in the calendar but all copyrights remain with the photographer.
9. Photographs will be credited with the photographer's name if used in the calendar.
10. The parish reserves the right to use what are judged to be the winning pictures on our website and in our publications.
11. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence shall be entered into.
12. The Sanderstead 2011 Calendar Competition is organised by the Justice & Care Team at All Saints' Sanderstead.
13. All entries must be uploaded by midnight 7 Sept 2010. No entries will be accepted after this time.
14. The organisers reserve the right not to publish your photographs.
15. Failure to comply with any of these rules may result in disqualification of the entry.
16. The Justice & Care Team reserves the right to disqualify any entry at its absolute discretion.
17. By entering the competition, the entrant verifies that he/she has read these "Terms and Conditions" and agrees to abide by them.
